

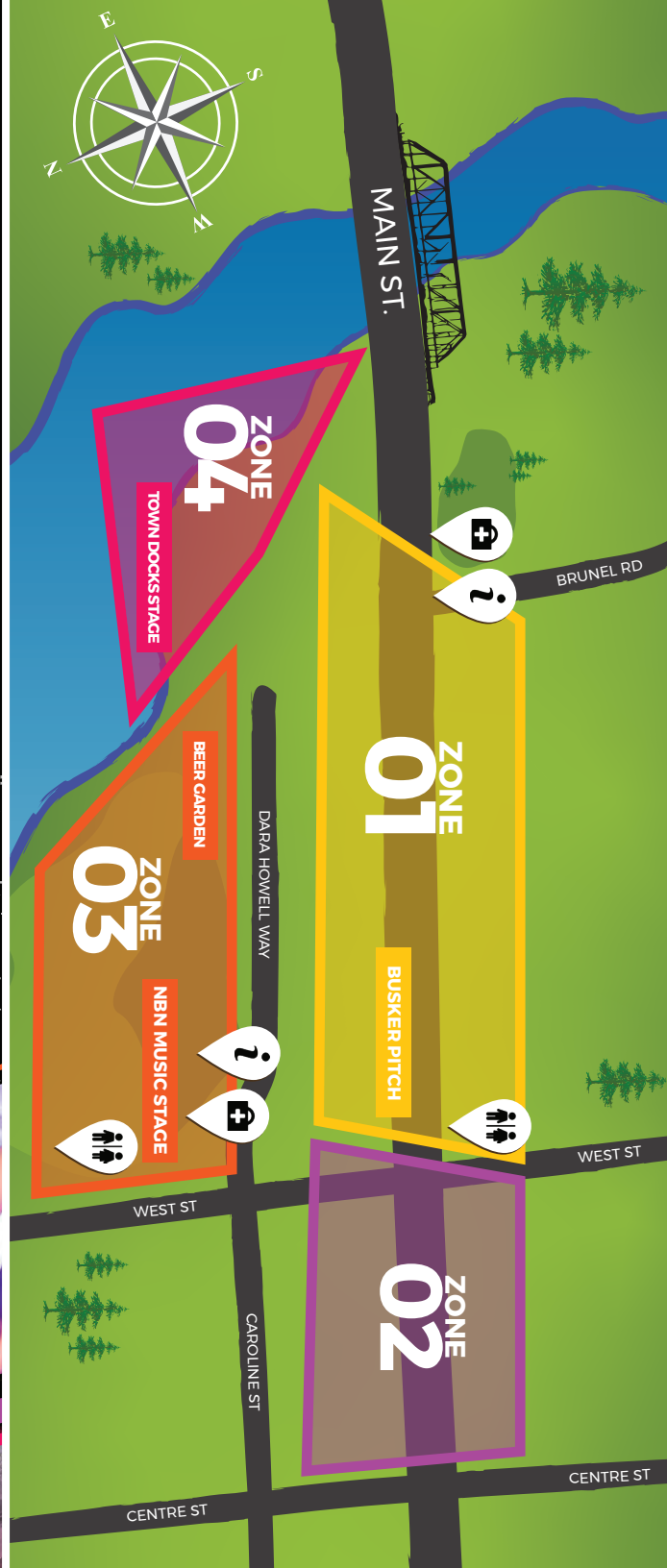
WELCOME TO THE 10TH ANNUAL NUIT BLANCHE NORTH
