Baby Song & Bounce | Apr 4- May 9

9:30am - 10:15am | 0-17 months

Exploring instruments, rhythm, movement, guitar sing-a-long, and object play (balls, scarves, bubbles, etc.) which nurture development and spark curiosity and provide caregivers the opportunity to bond with their little ones.



Disco Ducks | Apr 6- May 11

10:00am - 10:45am | 18 months - 4

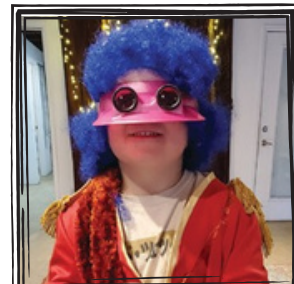
