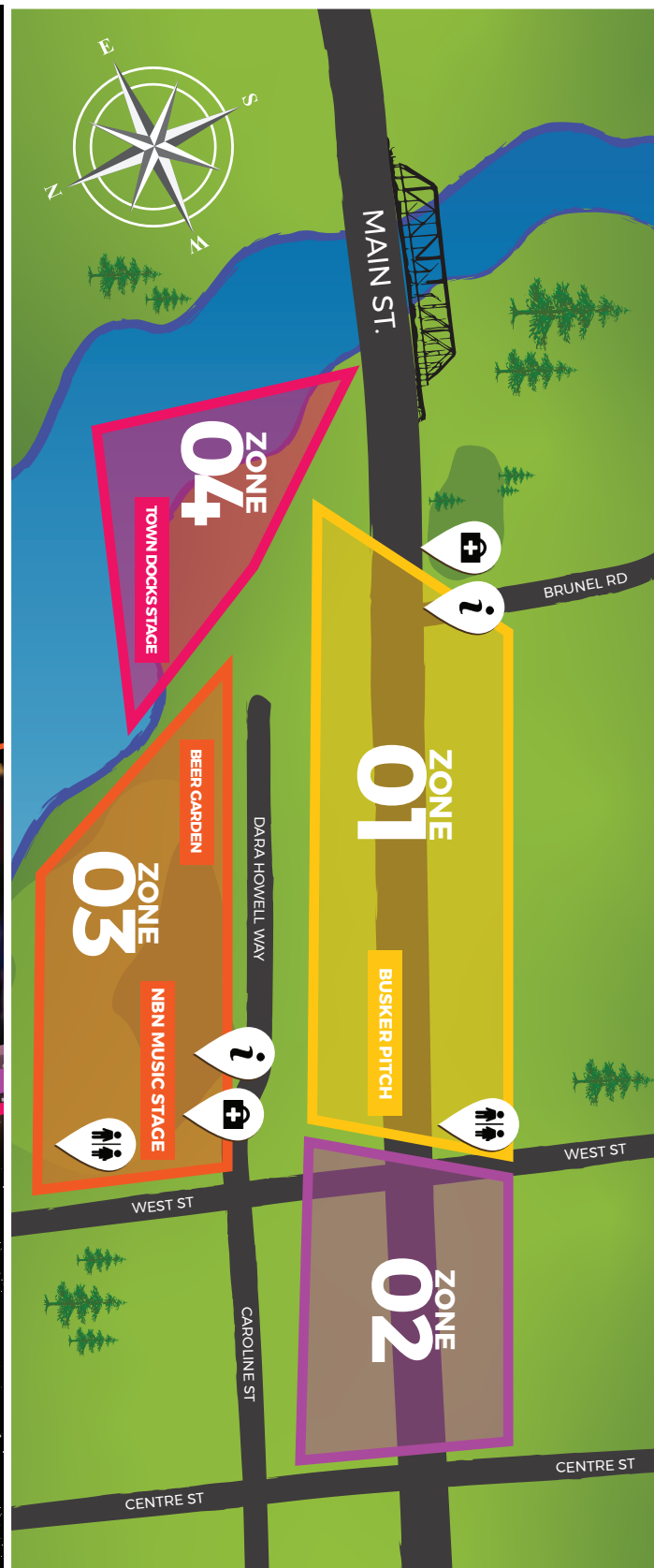
IMPORTANT INFORMATION
