She graduated from the Vocal program at The University of Western Ontario with an honours degree in Music Education, specializing in both Vocal and Instrumental music.

She is the Arts Department Curriculum Leader and Music director at Twin Lakes Secondary School in Orillia since 2003 where she conducts the schools' choir and jazz band. During her years at Twin Lakes she has music directed many stage productions such as Footloose, Thunder Glee, The Wiz, Thunder Live, Legally Blonde, Thunder Rock, Mamma Mia, Thunder Years, and Cinderella.

Outside of her teaching career, Christina has performed in and been the Music Director for many Mariposa Arts Theatre productions in the past 25 years. Along with her performing, teaching, and conducting career, Christina is a founding member of a cappella consort choir entitled "Quire", is the alto section lead at St. James Anglican Church in Orillia, and is the mother of two beautiful children whom she adores.

Lauren holds a Bachelor of Music from the University of Toronto and has been a member of the RCME College of Examiners for 40 years. Later this summer, Lauren will be travelling to Durham Cathedral in northern England to perform there with the Peterborough Singers. RANDY HOOVER | BAND

Randy Hoover is a familiar face on the Orillia music scene. He has a Bachelor of Music and Bachelor of Education from the University of Western Ontario and a Master's degree in Education from St. Mary's University.

He holds an Associate Diploma from the Royal Conservatory of Music in Trumpet Performance. Randy is the current music director of the Orillia Concert Band and the Orillia Big Band. He plays Flugel horn in the Phoenix Jazz Ensemble. He has been music director of the South Shores Orchestra (Nova Scotia). Randy has directed and performed in several musical productions.



JORDAN CLAYTON | STRINGS

Jordan Clayton is a passionate violinist, violist, and music educator based in London, Ontario. He holds a Bachelor of Arts and Master of Arts in Violin Performance from Western University, and a Bachelor of Education from the University of Ottawa. In addition to his work as a private teacher, Jordan is currently Music Director of the Forest City School for Strings, where he serves as the Junior Orchestra Conductor, a senior chamber music coach, and as a violin class instructor.

Over the past ten years, Jordan has enjoyed a freelance career playing locally with Magisterra Soloists, London Symphonia, the Kitchener-Waterloo Symphony, and the International Symphony Orchestra (Sarnia). From 2015 to 2022, Jordan served as the Outreach Coordinator for Magisterra Soloists, and was also the founding director of their summer program for young string players, the Magisterra Summer String Institute from 2020 to 2022. He is preparing for his second summer as co-director of the FCSS Summer Music Camp and his fourth year on faculty with the Camp musical de Québec in Québec City. Jordan is greatly inspired by the pedagogical heritage gifted to him by his many mentors and colleagues, incorporating elements from the traditional German school of violin playing, as well as the Suzuki and Létourneau methods.



ANDRE WAHL | GUITAR

Before settling down in Huntsville, Andre spent 37 years working as a freelance producer/engineer/mixer across Canada and internationally, working with such artists as Anne Murray, Rush, Shania Twain, Hawksley Workman, Madison Violet, Duran Duran, Pink Floyd, and Mudvayne, to name a few.

Additionally to production, Andre continues his career as a professor at Canadore College in the Music Production, Composition for Film and Audio Recording Program.
