

DIRECTORS MESSAGE

From its beginnings as a concept album on LP in 1970, Jesus Christ Superstar evolved quickly into a piece of musical theatre that tells the story of Jesus's last week from Judas's perspective. Unlike a typical Broadway show, Superstar is more of an opera in that there is no dialogue, and no script that specifies details of time, place, setting, or stage directions.

We simply have the musical score. Thus, our first task as a directorial triumvirate was to decide if we would set our story 2000 years ago, or in 1970, or in 2025. We settled on All Of The Above. This universal tale of oppression, rebellion, conflict, power, injustice, and the question - Who are we in the face of it? Can we answer in love? Do what Jesus would do? Once we had cast the show and selected most of the production specialists, we let our imaginations guide us towards the depiction you are seeing today.

We want to thank the community for coming together to make this show, this experience happen. It is a beautiful reflection of the village of love and possibility that surrounds us. What a pleasure it has been to create with you!

JESUS CHRIST SUPERSTAR

SYNOPSIS

Jesus Christ Superstar will be familiar, in basic fact, to anyone with knowledge of western religion. Borrowing from the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John, the musical tells the story of the last seven days of Jesus Christ's life. As the show opens, apostle Judas Iscariot is growing concerned that Jesus' followers will be perceived as a threat to the occupying Roman Empire. Indeed, priests Caiaphas, Annas and more gather and agree that Jesus and his movement must be crushed. An exalted Jesus arrives in Jerusalem only to find the temple filled with unsavory merchants and money lenders.

Overrun by a flood of people needing his help, he tells them to heal themselves, and his confidante Mary Magdalene has to calm him down. Judas, fearing the movement is getting out of Jesus' control, goes to the Romans and tells them Jesus will be in the Garden of Gethsemane the following night. He receives 30 pieces of silver as payment. At the Garden, Judas arrives with Roman soldiers and identifies Jesus by kissing him on the cheek. Jesus is arrested and sent to Caiaphas, then Pontius Pilate and finally King Herod, who condemns his to death on the cross.

Sherisse McGuey, Co-Director, Vocal Coach, Rehearsal Pianist

Sherisse Laurence McGuey has been performing music since the age of three. She sang and played at community events as a young girl and started working in television in her teens. She travelled with CBC concerts series across the Prairies and moved to Toronto. She won the "best new artist" for her original composition in the American Song Festival. She was chosen out of 400 people to co-host the CTV show "Circus" which became the first Canadian TV show to be syndicated worldwide.

Sherisse continued to perform on TV, radio and live shows, and in 1986 she was the first Canadian to compete in the Eurovision Song Contest. She moved to Muskoka in 1990 and played at Deerhurst and various events. She became involved with the Rotary shows and was part of the team that created the Huntsville Festival of the Arts. Sherisse performed the role of Mary Magdalene in the opening show for the Algonquin Theatre in 2005 which fueled her desire to bring Jesus Christ Superstar back for the 20th Anniversary of our wonderful Theatre.






